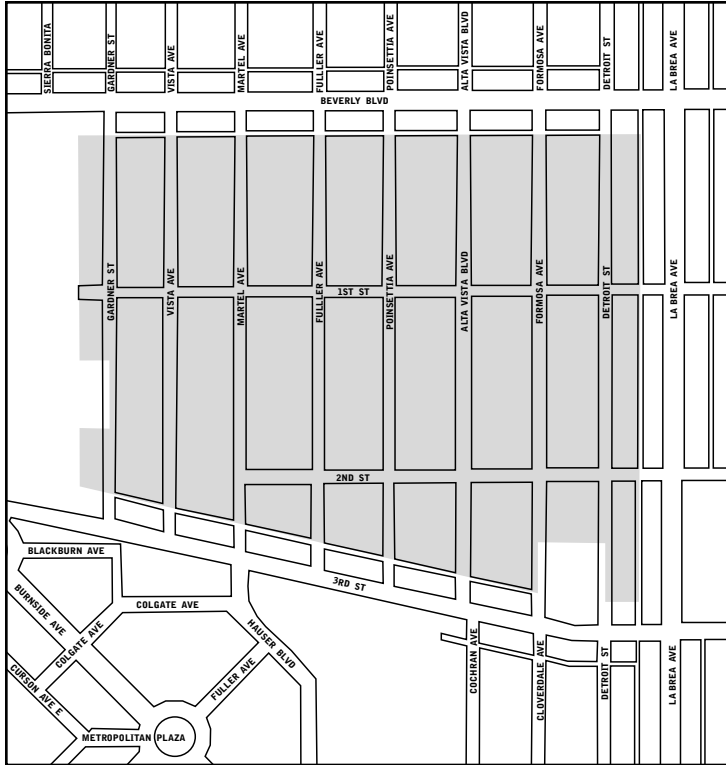


Miracle Mile North (1990)



THE MIRACLE MILE NORTH HPOZ IS MADE UP PRIMARILY of single-family homes with uniform setback, size, and scale, as well as similar ages and styles. The majority of the one-story homes were built from 1924–1941, reflecting the popular architectural themes of the time. More than half the homes in the area were constructed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style, with a smattering of Tudor Revival and American Colonial Revival styles built as well. Prominent architects Paul R. Williams, Gerard R. Colcord, and Morgan, Walls and Clements designed houses in this neighborhood, as well as contractor Spyros Ponty of South Carthay fame. This neighborhood, though compact, is rich in historic resources, with two Historic–Cultural Monuments only two blocks apart.
