DOCENTS & COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- Special Tour Docent:** The Conservancy offers occasional historic, architectural, and neighborhood house tours throughout the year. Volunteers are needed for these one-time only special tours.
- Walking Tour Docent:** The Conservancy offers Saturday morning architectural walking tours. The required seven week training class is held every 12 to 18 months.
- Community Outreach:** Volunteers are needed to staff Conservancy membership/tour information tables at Conservancy and other community events.
- Miscellaneous:** From time to time the Conservancy needs a few extra hands to help with things like event set-up/break-down, crowd control, and other non-specific event-related jobs.

COMMITTEES

- Historic Theatres Committee:** The HTC promotes the preservation of historic theatres in Los Angeles County as economically viable community, cultural, and architectural resources. Activities include researching local theatre histories, writing nominations, and conducting oral histories. The committee meets quarterly.
 - Last Remaining Seats Committee:** An HTC sub-committee, plans the annual *Last Remaining Seats* film series, and other theatre related endeavors. This sub-committee meets monthly.
- Modern Committee:** The Modern Committee's mission is to promote an appreciation and understanding of post WWII architecture in Los Angeles County. The committee meets once a month to discuss advocacy issues in addition to hosting occasional tours and lectures.

ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

- Office Aide:** The Conservancy office is a very busy place, and there are dozens of things that volunteers can assist with including phones, mailings, filing, and special projects. Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Archives:** Work with Conservancy information and image archives, scanning, cataloguing and identifying resources.
- Advocacy Support:**
 - Assist with special projects involving the city's historic neighborhoods and structures, including conducting historical research and completing nomination forms.
 - Emergency Phone bank/mailings to help get the word out on breaking preservation issues.
