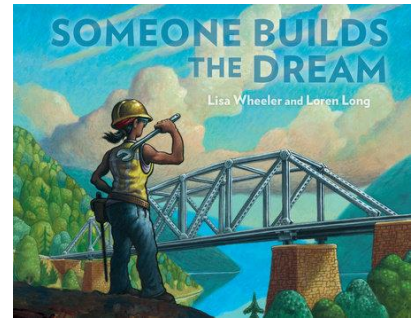




Someone Builds the Dream

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Questions and Activities

1. Think about all of the people that helped build each of the structures in the story. Who helped the architect create a building, or the artist build a sculpture, or the engineer build a bridge? Why is it important to know about all of the people that help build a dream?
2. Why did the people in the story dream about creating different types of buildings and structures? How are each of the buildings and structures important for the communities that use them?
3. Take a walk outside and observe the buildings that surround you. Imagine the person who dreamed up the idea of one of the buildings, and imagine all the people who helped construct it. Write the name of the building or draw in the center of a sheet of paper, and write down or draw all the people you think helped create the building around it.
4. Imagine you are building the dream like the people in the story. What type of building would you dream and who would be the team that would help you build it? How could the building you create be helpful for your community, like the ones in the story?



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
